



The M.D. of Ranchland administration building is located in the Chain Lakes Provincial Park.

*** FUEL ALERT *** There is no retail fuel station out here. The closest retail fuel is 38 kilometers from the Ranchland administration building. Please check your fuel level before leaving the last town on the way out here!

Directions from Calgary area

South on Hwy 2 to Nanton.

At the south end of Nanton turn west on Hwy 533.

Proceed west on Hwy 533 for 38 kms to junction with Hwy 22.

*** Note: There is a 90 degree left turn to make to stay on Hwy 533 about 10 kms out of Nanton;

Don't miss it! If you realize you are driving on a gravel road then you must have missed this turn.

Upon arrival at junction Hwy 22 continue west (after obeying the STOP sign of course) into the Chain Lakes Provincial Park entrance.

Proceed into Park for about 800 meters and you can't miss it on the left.

Estimated time to get here from Calgary (south end of Stoney Trail): 75 minutes.

Directions from Calgary area (Scenic route)

Pick a route (22X or Hwy 7) west over to Hwy 22 (the Cowboy Trail) and go south.

Go thru the Town of Black Diamond and then the Village of Longview.

Mind the speed zones in Longview – patrolled often.

Proceed south of Longview for another 40 kms on Hwy 22 to Hwy 533.

At this junction turn west to enter the Chain Lakes Provincial Park.

Proceed into Park for about 800 meters and you can't miss it on the left.

Estimated time to get here from Calgary (south end of Stoney Trail): 85 – 90 minutes.

Directions from the South (Hwy 3).

From Hwy 3 turn north onto Hwy 22 (the Cowboy Trail) This turn off is just west of Lundbreck about 3 kms.

Proceed north on Hwy 22 for approximately 70 kms to Hwy 533.

At this junction turn west and enter the Chain Lakes Provincial Park.

Proceed into Park for about 800 meters and you can't miss it on the left.
