

Seasonal Employment Opportunity

The Municipal District of Ranchland No. 66 seeks qualified individual(s) for Seasonal Park Maintenance Service Workers.



Term: Five months, May 1 to September 29, 2023.

Rotating shift work that will include some weekends and holidays, 40 hours per week, some overtime may be required.

Area: Based out of the MD of Ranchland administration building, located in Chain Lakes Provincial Park. Servicing Chain Lakes Provincial Park, Maycroft & Campgrounds along the Forestry Trunk Road. The municipality may be able to assist with living arrangements if necessary.

Wage Range: \$17-24 per hour based on skills and experience.

Key Responsibilities:

This is a labour/cleaning position with a significant amount of janitorial work including:

- Cleaning and maintaining vault toilets and kitchen facilities
- Grass mowing and trimming
- Garbage collecting
- Carrying and restocking firewood
- Fielding inquiries from the public (campers and recreationists) in a respectful manner
- Painting and performing general maintenance
- Operating riding mowers, UTVs, and grass trimmers
- Performing other duties as required

Work Environment:

- Outdoor work during all kinds of weather
- Required to drive to remote campgrounds to perform duties
- Must be capable of physically demanding work in any weather conditions
- Must be willing to work weekends and holidays
- Ability to work independently with minimum supervision
- Be comfortable working in a wilderness setting
