POLICY STATEMENT:

Weed control resulting from non-compliance with a Weed Notice adds significant administrative costs and exposes the Municipality to additional financial and legal risk. Therefore, all custom and contracted work resulting from non-compliance with a Weed Notice shall be subject to a surcharge as per the Schedule of ASB Rates and Fees in effect one day after the date stipulated as the date "Action is to be completed on or before" on the Weed Notice.

GUIDELINES:

- 1. Invoices for weed control work resulting from non-compliance with a Weed Notice will include the statement "Non-compliance with a Weed Notice Surcharge" and will display the current surcharge rate and resulting sum.
- 2. For contracted work the surcharge will be added to the contractor's invoice and be payable to the municipality.
- 3. The surcharge will be based on the invoice total less the goods and service tax (GST).
